Purpose of Job:

The houseman performs a combination of support tasks within various departments of the Club. The houseman will assist with assuring that the overall look and feel of the Tower Club by supporting initiatives related to such departments as housekeeping, facilities, food and beverage, fitness and shuttle as requested. The position is also a main support for all seasonal projects.

Essential Functions and Responsibilities:

- Storage, inventory, and upkeep of Banquet/Event Equipment, all Tower Club storage equipment
- Ensure all areas are presentable, including touching up on paint as requested.
- Change out light bulbs as necessary and keep a variety of bulbs in stock.
- Assist with the care, cleaning and maintenance of all furniture.
- Support the pool cleaning as needed and directed by the facilities team
- Support the pool operation during peak use
- Coordinate seasonal project needs with housekeeping for such projects as carpet cleaning, window washing, floor buffing and other requested.
- Ensure First Aid Station(s) meet company accepted standards and are stocked properly by working with HR.
- Drive the Ontario shuttle use as needed
- Assist with identifying and reporting maintenance issues to the facilities department.
- Exhibit superb customer service skills by always greeting members in a kind and courteous manner.
- Be present during special events when assigned and assist in cleaning /setup/breakdown for the event.
- Close the pool past the fitness attendant schedule out time
- Assure that furniture floor design/layout is maintained after an event and prior each season.
- Assist with trash removal as assigned.
- Help with over spring clean up after snow melt.

- Seasonally power wash deck, service area and common areas that aren't vehicle accessible as requested.
- Assist with minor repairs as requested.
- Oversee recycling, trash area and schedule pickups.
- Other duties as assigned.

Education, experience and qualifications

- 2-3 years houseman experience required.
- Bilingual (English and Spanish) Preferred but not required.
- Clean driving record.
- Excellent attention to detail.
- Professional attitude is required.
- Ability to work independently.
- Ability to follow instructions.
- Must be flexible to work any shift, weekends, holidays and during high impact seasons.

- Use hands to lift, carry, or pull objects that may be heavy.
