Purpose of Job:

The Talisker Club Shuttle Driver is responsible for safely and efficiently transporting Members and Guests to and from the Tower, Courchevel and Clubhouse.

Essential Functions and Responsibilities:

- Familiarize yourself with Member's names.
- Always use Mr. and Mrs. Followed by last name, unless asked otherwise.
- Stay up do speed on changing reservations.
- Assist Members and guests with loading ski gear and belongings into and out of the shuttle.
- Open doors for Members & guests upon entering the shuttle and upon departing the shuttle.
- Answer shuttle telephone in a courteous, friendly and timely fashion.

- Do vehicle walk through at beginning and end of shift before filling our Shift Note.
- When snowing, keep Members' vehicle windows and doors free of snow.
- Be available to help with transportation of Club supplies as needed.

- Maintain a working knowledge of Talisker Club, the weekly events at Talisker Club, and the current snow and weather conditions.
- Report to work on time
- Flexible to an ever-changing work schedule.
- Report to work in uniform with a neat, clean appearance.
- Ability to interact with and engage members in conversation.
- Ability to lift and transport 50 lbs.
- Ability to operate a motor vehicle in winter conditions.
- Ability to work weekends, evenings, and holidays.
- Respect company vehicles and equipment.
- Ability to report mechanical needs in a timely fashion to management.
- Report damages or needed repairs in a timely fashion to management.
- Keep phone charged and turned on at all times.
- Keep vehicle fuel level at least half tank at all times.
- Keep interior and exterior of vehicle clean at all times.
- Other duties as assigned.
