Talisker Club Rules

FORETEES BEST PRACTICES & GUEST POLICIES

• Each Member will be restricted to a maximum of two (2) tee times per day. Additional tee times may be made through the Pro Shop forty-eight (48) hours in advance, subject to availability or on a limited basis approval from the Director of Golf.

• Tee Times are available for booking seven days in advance beginning at 7am Mountain Time via the ForeTees App.

• Tee Times will be open to book via the ForeTees App (for example: if you are a twosome, the player 3 and player 4 spots will be open, allowing another Member to book into those positions in the same Tee Time.)

• When selecting Xs on the Tee Sheet, the following is in place:

• Three days prior to your Tee Time, you will receive an automated email reminding you to fill in your X on the Tee Sheet.

• You will have one day/24hrs to populate a Member name or Accompanied Guest name into the X.

• Two days prior to your Tee Time, if you have not populated a name into the X as described above, all X place holders in your Tee Time will be automatically deleted

• The newly created opening from the deleted X will now be an open player position for any Member to book into and will show as Available/Open on ForeTees

• Any populated Member or Accompanied Guest names will remain; only the X will be deleted

• The goal is to allow for more Members to golf and utilize the golf course in a more efficient manner.

• Accompanied Guest names will need to be populated in full with first name, last name

• You will be able to add and cancel Tee Times within 24hrs/same day from the App

• When canceling, be sure to only cancel you and/or your group if you are sharing a Tee Time with another single or twosome

- Members are expected to provide complete player information when booking tee times.
- When necessary, twosomes and singles may (will) be grouped together at the discretion of the Pro Shop.
- On a limited basis, the Director of Golf reserves the right to allow fivesomes to play the golf course, when not in conflict with normal Member play, and to divide the group if they are unable to maintain their position on the golf course. Pace of play must be kept.

• Each Member is restricted to a maximum of three (3) accompanied guests per day. A forecaddie will be required for groups with three guests. On a limited basis, the Director of Golf may approve additional guests.

• Each guest may play the Signature golf course or use the practice areas a maximum of five (5) times per Membership year regardless of the sponsoring Member.



PACE OF PLAY

• A brisk pace of play is expected from all players to insure an enjoyable experience for the entire Membership. A foursome playing an eighteen (18) hole round in four (4) hours would be considered an appropriate pace of play.

• If a group is unable to maintain their position on the golf course and is restricting play behind them, they will be obligated to allow the following group(s) to play through at the earliest opportunity. When necessary, a member of the Pro Shop may be placed on the golf course to regulate the speed of play and enforce the golf course rules.

• Foursomes will have standing on the golf course at all times. Twosomes and singles should not expect to automatically play through foursomes during busy periods and should not exert undue pressure on foursomes ahead of them.

GOLF ATTIRE

• It is expected that Members, their family, and guests will dress in traditional golf attire befitting of a premier private club. Worn-out, items with holes or unkempt attire will not be permitted. Any improperly dressed Members, family or guests will be asked to change prior to using the Club golf facilities.

• Acceptable attire for men on the Club golf facilities will include shirts with regular or mock collars and sleeves with slacks or golf shorts worn to the knee. Men's shirts are to be tucked in. Outerwear must be designed for the intention of golf.

• Unacceptable attire for men on the Club golf facilities will include, without limitation, sleeveless shirts, t-shirts, sweatpants, casual hoodies, graphic designed tops, warm-ups, bathing suits, cargo shorts or pants, fitness or tennis shorts and jeans or jean shorts of any color.

• Acceptable attire for women on the Club golf facilities include blouses of an appropriate style consisting of a collar or sleeves. Skirts/skorts should be of conservative length. Slacks, capris, leggings and outerwear must be designed for the intention of golf.

• Unacceptable attire for women on the Club golf facilities will include, without limitation, halter tops, tank tops, t-shirts, sweatpants, casual hoodies, graphic designed tops, warm-ups, bathing suits, cargo shorts or pants, tennis dresses or shorts, yoga pants, fitness shorts and jeans or jean shorts of any color.


• Hats are to be worn forward facing.

• Any shoes worn on the Club golf facilities must be spikeless or have some type of soft spikes. Shoes with metal or ceramic spikes are not permitted anywhere on Club property.

• Members are responsible for informing their guests of the proper golf attire in advance of arriving to the Club. Improperly dressed golfers will be asked to change before using the Club golf facilities.

ETIQUETTE

- All players are expected to maintain or improve the condition of the golf course as a result of their round by avoiding wet areas with golf carts, raking bunkers after use, filling divots with seed mix and repairing ball marks on the putting greens.
- Cellular telephones, tablets and laptops must be in silent mode and used in an order to not be disruptive to other Members. If a phone call must be taken, is it expected that Members and guests do so in an area that does not inhibit the enjoyment of the Club by others.
- Walking on the golf course is only permitted when the course is closed or prior to play. When temperatures are below 40 degrees, it is especially important to refrain from walking on turf grass as frost damage can occur.
- Fishing on the golf course lakes is restricted to when the course is closed, prior to play or when approved through the Pro Shop. Single barbless hooks and catch and release are required.




LOCAL RULES

USGA Rules govern all play except where modified by the following local rules:

- -Penalty Areas are defined by red stakes and lines
- -Out-of-bounds is defined by white stakes and lines
- -Model Local Rule E-5 (Alternative to Stroke-and-Distance Relief for lost Ball or ball Out-of-Bounds) is in effect.

See the diagram below for proper relief under this modified rule:







HANDICAPPING & TOURNAMENTS

Members who wish to participate in Club-sanctioned competitions must have a valid GHIN number for WHS Handicap purposes.

All Competitions will use the USGA recommendation for handicap allocations.

Partner Events (Member/Member, Member/Guests (both Men's and Ladies), and Four-Ball Match Play) will have a maximum of 10 stroke differential in handicaps between partners. The higher handicap index will be adjusted down.

In the event of a tie, unless otherwise stated in the rules sheet, the USGA Recommendation for breaking the tie using the scorecard will be utilized: last nine holes total, last six holes total, last 3 holes total, and then last hole.

Registration for weekly events (Ladies Day, Men's Tee it Up, and Couples) will close two days prior to the event at 4pm. Late registrations will be accommodated on a space available basis only. Cancellations after the registration deadline will result in associated event charges. Majors and Member/Guests have a registration deadline/waitlist policy in force.

Pace of Play in Tournaments will be monitored. If your group is out of position, you may be asked to move to the next tee box and halve the hole.

Talisker Club "Rule of 85" – if your age combined with your handicap index exceed 85, you have the option to move up a set of tees.

If you want to have more fun on the golf course and maybe play a little faster, TEE IT FORWARD may be just the game for you. TEE IT FORWARD can help you play from tees best suited to your game, based on how far you hit the ball.

This new national initiative from The PGA of America and United States Golf Association will take place at golf facilities nationwide from July 5-17, but you can do this anytime.
